Compass Affordable Housing Board Spotlight: Randy Peterson

eet our newest Board Member, Randy Peterson. Randy grew up on his family's farm in Michigan as one of six kids. While attending Central Michigan University on a full-ride scholarship that required "meaningful community service," he began volunteering with the local Big Brothers Big Sisters; it sounded like a fun way to complete his service on the weekends. He met his first "Little Brother" at age 20 and has had seven little brothers: two in Michigan and five in Tucson.

For the past 25 years, Randy has worked exclusively for nonprofit organizations in Tucson, including KXCI Community Radio, the Humane Society of Southern

Arizona, and Big Brothers Big Sisters of Southern Arizona. His current role is the Development Officer for Imago Dei Middle School, a tuition-free school with a mission of breaking the cycles of poverty for our kids and their families. When he is not working, Randy enjoys watching classic game shows and movies, sports, spending time with his dog, and attending concerts with friends.

For Randy, serving on the board of CAH is a natural progression to making our community a better place to live. "Growing up on a farm, we lived in an old farmhouse that my grandparents had gifted to my parents, so my folks never had to worry about a house payment. It wasn't luxurious...But it was always a roof over our heads and a place to call home. I want that for everyone."

Randy sees the issues surrounding poverty first-hand: "At our school, improvements in housing lead to better test scores, better attendance, fewer behavioral issues, and greater overall achievement in the kids." Randy shares, "Is it too big to dream that we solve homelessness in our community? Everyone benefits from affordable housing, not just the people living in it. Everyone has a role to play in making it possible in our community. Donate, advocate, educate, and get out and vote!



Affordable Housing Myth #6: Affordable Housing Looks Like "Cheap Housing"

Reality: Affordable housing today is often designed to blend in with its surroundings, using the same style and materials as other homes. Many people may not realize they are looking at affordable housing. The term "affordable" doesn't refer to low-quality construction or operation; instead, it signifies that housing is more economical for working families. It is supported by funding from both public and private sources. It is subject to the same building restrictions and design standards as market-rate housing and sometimes even higher standards when public funding is involved.

Nonprofit developers have community-based boards of directors committed to the community's long-term well-being. These boards ensure affordable housing is integrated into the community and managed effectively over time.

Public agencies that finance affordable housing also have a stake in ensuring that their investment benefits the community in the long run. Thoughtful planning with input from the community can alleviate concerns about unattractive developments.

High architectural standards and proper maintenance also affect property values, particularly those of affordable rental properties. Well-maintained affordable housing developments designed and constructed with consideration for the community's architectural and aesthetic preferences may even contribute to increasing property values.
